Book reports are to be turned in typed, using Times New Roman and 12 Font. Students should double space the book report. Please restate the question in your answer. (For example: I chose to read this book because I liked the previous book in the series and the main character, Julie, seems just like me.)

You need to follow the outline below. Students must score a passing grade on their AR test in order to type a book report.

- 1. *Book title* (in italics) and author name.
- 2. Reading Level and number of pages.
- 3. AR reading test score.
- 4. Explain why you chose this book to read.
- List two ideas or facts that is new to you from reading this book. Use details to explain your answer.
- 6. How did you like this non-fiction book? Write a friendly letter, using the appropriate body style, to a friend. In your letter, provide two reasons why you would recommend this book to your friend or provide two reasons why you would not recommend this book to your friend. (Saying it is good or not good is not considered a good reason.)
