## Classroom User Policy

Prior to signing this Agreement, please read and sign the Winona RIII School District Acceptable User Policy (AUP). If you have any questions about this policy, contact the Winona IT Department.

The Winona Middle School is pleased to offer our students technological opportunities in the form of notebook computers, digital cameras, scanners, Smartboards, etc. Students will also have access to the Internet. To access the Internet, students must agree to the District Acceptable User Policy (AUP), as well as the Classroom User Policy (CUP).

Access to the Internet in school as a tool for learning will be automatic. Parents should be advised that they may indicate that they do not want their child to access the Internet at school. Should a parent or legal guardian prefer that a student not have Internet access or a student lose their Internet privileges, use of the computer is still possible for more traditional assignments such as typing Word documents.

### Student Guidelines for Internet/Computer Use

Network access is a privilege. Each student must agree to the following set of rules in order to use the Internet.

- 1) The Internet is for school projects only; not for playing, checking emails, going to chatrooms, etc.
- 2) At no time should a student give personal information (name, address, phone number, school, etc.)
- 3) No threatening pictures/messages are to be sent to anyone.
- 4) Do not load/remove any game or system or software on the computer.
- 5) Only enter the links as requested by your teacher!
- 6) Anything you save can be seen by your teacher or by Sean at anytime.
- 7) I will not damage the computer in any manner.
- 8) I will be polite and not use inappropriate language.

Failing to comply with these rules will result in the loss of access in addition to other disciplinary or legal actions by the school district.
